

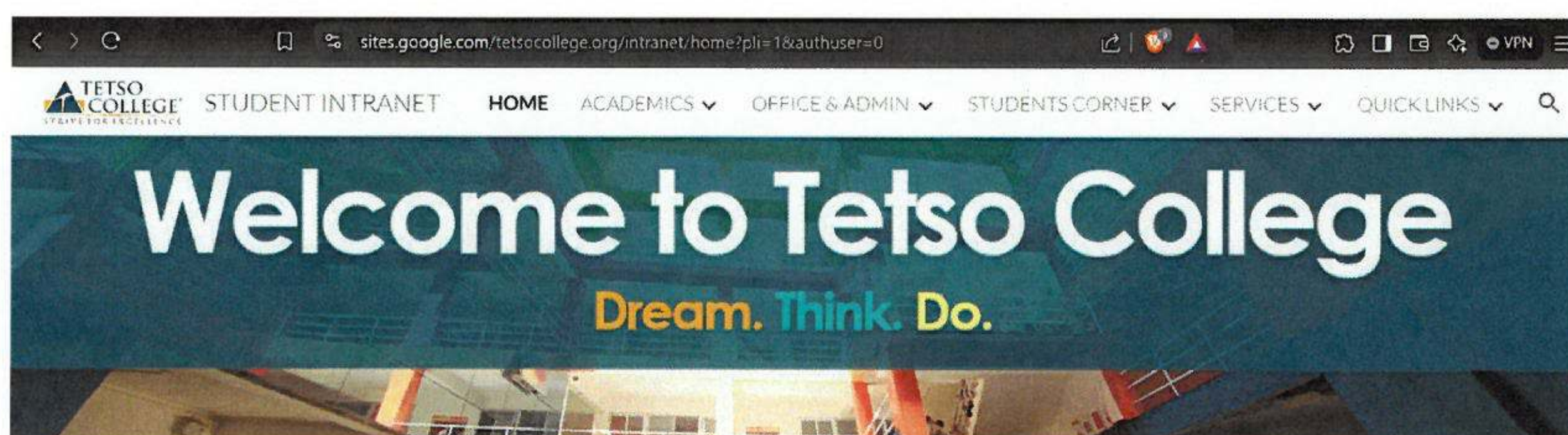




This is to notify all the students that Admit cards for their odd semester examination will be issued on **4th November (Friday) 2022**, in their respective Honours classes.

Degree Level (BA | BBA | BCOM)

The degree level programme is a three year course comprising of six semesters and is affiliated to Nagaland University.

A) The Degree Examination System:

- The degree level follows the semester system. The duration of Semester I, III and V shall be from June to November (6 months) while the duration of Semester II, IV and VI shall be from December to May (6 months) during which Admission, Course Work, Conduct of Examinations and Declaration of Results shall be completed, including Semester Break.
- Nagaland University conducts IV and VI End-Semester Examinations while the remaining is conducted by the College. For all the end-semester Examinations, questions papers are prepared by the University.
- There are two types of programmes at the degree level. One is a General BA/BBA/BCom degree while the other is an Honours Degree. Students may take up a General BA/BBA/BCom degree or specialize in a subject of their choice by taking up an Honours programme. Please refer to the college prospectus or contact the office for the list of Honours programmes available.



B) Honours Programmes: The Honours Degree is for those students who would like to specialize in a specific field, for eg. English, Accountancy, History, Sociology etc. To take up honours, students must fulfil any of the minimum criteria given below:

Policy:

Tetso College will implement e-governance in all aspects, including:

- **Website:** The college website will serve as an information hub containing details about the college, activities, notices, courses, etc. A designated service provider will maintain the website. Training will be provided to staff for content updates. An IT/Media team will oversee regular updates, maintenance, and improvement of the main external college website whereas Deans, supervisors of various departments along with IT/Media will oversee both updation, maintenance of Staff and Student Intranet. Both student and faculty intranet can be accessed only via college mail ID, outside users will not be able to access these intranet websites.
- **Student Admission:** An open and transparent admission process will be followed. The college's admission brochure and guidelines will be available on the website. An online admission portal will be used for application management, including admissions tracking, fee submission.
- **Accounts:** The college will maintain accounts using software like Tally, Qfix ensuring regular updates and efficient record management. Financial reports, including profit and loss statements and balance sheets, will be generated through this software. collection of admission fees through online payment systems with appropriate security measures taken to maintain data confidentiality. Staff training and software updates will be conducted regularly. Additionally, the college may consider using other software like PFMS for government funds management, payroll management systems, and online payment gateways.
- **Library:** Tetso College will maintain a well-stocked library with a focus on expanding e-learning resources for students and faculty. Subscriptions to journals and books (both physical and electronic) will

be continued, with recommendations encouraged from students and teachers. Koha Open source software has been implemented to track all the records of the books, issuance and return of the books, and renewal of books. The library will utilize an easy-to-use Integrated Library Management System (ILMS) with features like:

- o Graphical User Interface (GUI)
 - o Unicode support and multilingual search
 - o Online Public Access Catalogue (OPAC) module for keyword searching
 - o Circulation module for member records and book management
 - o Database management tools
 - o Plagiarism checking software for original writing promotion
- **Administration & Human Resources:**
 - o A dedicated Human resource software will be used for HR management.
 - o Attendance Management Software: Staff and faculty will utilize software to record and track student attendance, internal assessments, etc. Monthly and semester reports will be generated for automatic calculation of internal assessment marks based on attendance.
 - o Paperless Administration: The college strives for a paperless administration by utilizing advanced Excel tools and file management systems. This will provide students with a hassle-free experience for accessing various services online. The college will continuously explore opportunities for further automation of administrative tasks.

- o Staff Training: Administrative staff will receive adequate training and development to stay updated on new technologies related to their roles.
- **Examination:** The college may adopt an online system for students to view internal assessment marks and report discrepancies. google forms facility comes along with google gSuite, which can be used for conducting online exams. All the necessary information related to exams are notified in college student intranet as well as email has been sent to all the students for the same.
- **Alumni Relations:** A dedicated alumni webpage will be created on the college website, offering registration, information about prominent alumni, feedback mechanisms, and other features. Collaboration with the alumni association will be encouraged for regular updates and database management.
- **E-waste Management:** Tetso College is committed to responsible technology usage and minimizing its environmental impact. A system will be established for proper disposal of e-waste and MoU with an E-waste management NGO will be explored
