

# Constitution of the Anti-ragging Committee

Following the UGC Regulations on curbing the menace of Ragging in Higher Educational Institutions, Tetso College has set up a committee to ensure that ragging does not take place anywhere in the campus. The College has Constituted the Anti Ragging Committee in the year 2011. It aims to provide a healthy atmosphere for the students.

#### Objectives:

To prevent any behavior that teases, humiliates, or treats a fresher or any other student with rudeness, whether through words or actions, and to stop rowdy or undisciplined activities that cause annoyance, hardship, or psychological harm, or instill fear in any student.

This includes forcing a student to do something that would shame, torment, or embarrass them, thereby affecting their physical or mental well-being. The goal is to eradicate ragging in all its forms from higher educational institutions by prohibiting it, preventing its occurrence, and punishing those who engage in it, as outlined in these regulations and applicable laws.

Educate students about the harmful and dehumanizing effects of ragging, highlighting its perverse nature. Take immediate and severe action against any reported ragging incidents, ensuring that those responsible are held accountable.

#### Functions of Committee:

- Investigate and Report: Investigate complaints from students, conduct enquiries, and submit reports to the Anti-Ragging Committee with recommended punishments for offenders.
- Undertaking Administration: Oversee the process of obtaining undertakings from students as per provisions.
- Workshop Organization: Organize workshops to educate students about the ill effects of ragging and promote a ragging-free environment.
- Contact Information: Provide students with contact details of designated persons to receive complaints or distress calls.
- Awareness Creation: Create awareness among students about the Anti-Ragging policy and its importance.
- Ragging Prevention: Take all necessary measures to prevent ragging within the campus and hostels.

The University Grants Commission (UGC) in India has established guidelines and norms to address and prevent ragging and sexual harassment in educational institutions. These measures are crucial for creating a safe and respectful environment for students. Here's a summary of the UGC norms related to anti-ragging and anti-sexual harassment:

### Anti-Ragging Norms:

- 1. Prohibition of Ragging:

 Educational institutions are required to take stringent measures to prevent ragging.

#### 2. Committee Formation:

- Institutions must form anti-ragging committees and squads to monitor and prevent ragging activities.
- The committee should include representatives from students, teachers, and parents.

#### 3. Student Awareness:

 Institutions must conduct awareness programs and workshops to educate students about the harmful effects of ragging and the consequences for those involved.

#### 4. Complaint Mechanism:

- A dedicated complaint mechanism should be in place, allowing victims or witnesses to report incidents of ragging anonymously if necessary.
- Institutions must ensure prompt and impartial investigation of complaints.

#### 5. Punishments:

 The UGC guidelines specify various punishments for those found guilty of ragging, including expulsion from the institution and legal actions.

#### 6. Affidavit Requirement:

 Students and their parents/guardians must submit affidavits at the time of admission, declaring that they are aware of the anti-ragging regulations and will abide by them.

**Ragging is Banned:** Ragging is strictly prohibited and considered a very serious offense. If one is aware or a victim of ragging, information must be immediately mediated to any concerned authority on the campus. In the event of any such reports, punishment for the violator(s) will be meted out as directed by the UGC and university rules.

### Every Student will be required to file an online anti ragging affidavit:

As per UGC regulations, it is mandatory for a college to register an F.I.R. with police against the culprits if any violence, physical abuse, sexual harassment, confinement etc. takes place with any fresher. After receiving any such complaint from the Helpline, it becomes the duty of the Head of the institution to register the F.I.R. with police within 24 hours.

In case of any incident of ragging then students may dial any of the local college authorities at (03862) 242484 (after office hours, hostellers may directly contact their Resident coordinators) or the all India toll free anti-ragging phone number 1800-180-5522.
